

PLEASE DON'T FORGET that for the next <u>two</u> Sundays (30 July and 6 August), the Sunday service will take place at St Paul's, while the final stage of electrical work is completed, and for the next <u>three</u> Wednesdays (26 July, 2 August and 9 August), there will be no midweek Communion.

The choir will take place every Tuesday, 4.30pm—6pm during term-time, and will join our Parish Choir for some key services throughout the year. While the children
